However, research shows that memories from younger days are often retained, especially music memories, even when a person suffers dementia. These can be reawakened using music and other material from those days.

MemoryLink was created for this purpose. Recorded hymns, choruses, Bible verses and prayers can be played on this easy-to-use digital player.

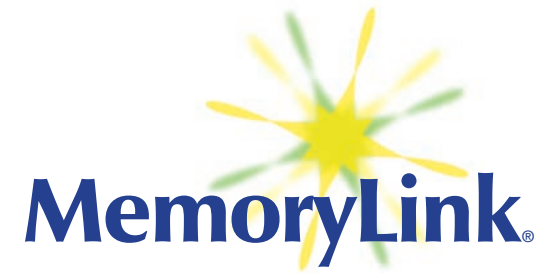
MemoryLink can provide comfort, encouragement and joy by reconnecting the ageing person to the Christian experiences of younger days.

MemoryLink has been designed mainly for people who are 60 and over, and were raised in the Protestant tradition. The material used in MemoryLink comes from an Australia-wide survey, where ageing people were asked to list the hymns, choruses, Bible passages and prayers they could still remember from their childhood. This is a resource for seniors as recommended by seniors.

“Even after my friend could no longer communicate with anyone in any way because of advancing dementia, he still sang along joyfully with the hymns and choruses on MemoryLink. It was his last means of communication. Praise God.”
